In the area where you live, you will find that there are various events and activities that anyone can participate in, and also other activities specifically for people from other countries. Why not get out and take part in them?

You can learn about the activities in your area through advertisements distributed to your accepting company or dormitory, or in a variety of other ways. You might see a notice on a bulletin board when you're out, or you might come upon an event in your area by chance. In addition, you can get information by inquiring at the local ward or municipal office. In some areas, there are also groups that organize international exchanges.

Fall is the season for school sports meets and other sports meets in local areas. You may have already participated in sports meets in your area with people at your accepting company. In some areas, there are groups that engage in regular public service activities, such as cleanup of roads and riverbanks and visiting elderly people in care facilities. Some areas also have Japanese classes for foreign residents, and events at which everyone can introduce others to the food and culture of their countries.
